SIMILE

It was as sour as a lemon.



A simile compares two different things, using the words "like" or "as."

METAPHOR

Tea is my pot of gold.



A figure of speech that states that one thing is another thing.

ALLITERATION

I make sentences super snappy.



The repetition of the same sound at the start of a series of words.

PERSONIFICATION

The bread leapt out of the toaster.



Giving a human quality or characteristic to something that is not human.

PUN

You really 'guac' my world!



Funny use of a word that has several meanings or sounds like another word.

RHYME

We all scream for ice cream!



A rhyme is when the ending sounds of two words sound alike.

ONOMATOPOEIA

The pizza plopped onto the plate with a cheesy thud.



A literary device in which a word is used to represent a sound.

IDIOM

The test was a piece of cake!



A common phrase that can't be understood by looking at its individual words.
